School lunches and ParentPay

We have had helpful feedback from students and parents about school lunches. We have shared this with Chartwells, our catering provider, and are in the process of exploring new providers. Year 8 Human Papiloma Virus (HPV) vaccinations – Tuesday 20 February

Click here for the e-consent form, please complete this even if you wish to refuse the vaccination.

The vaccination is free and recommended for young people to protect them against the HPV virus which increases the risk of developing some cancers later in life. For more information, click here

PLEASE NOTE: Public Health England requires the nurses to see all Year 8s. If a consent form hasn't been received then the nurses can undertake a Gillick competency. This means a young person can consent for

the vaccine if the nurses deem them competent enough to understand what the vaccines are for. Please















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note as part of the process the nurses have to demonstrate they have attempted to contact parents to gain consent. Nurses will aim to get a verbal consent on the phone before undertaking Gillick with a student.
