Dear parents,

I would like to inform you of a change in our afterschool detentions procedures, as we believe in fostering a sense of responsibility and accountability in our students.

Beginning Monday 8th January 2024, students will no longer be physically collected at the end of period 5 and taken to their afterschool detention. Instead, we encourage students to take initiative, show integrity and attend the designated detentions independently.

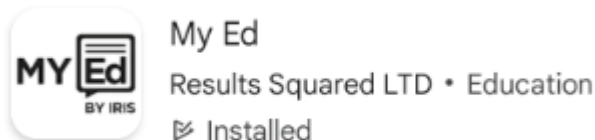
As a reminder, our current detention system includes:

- ✓ 10-minute afterschool detention – teacher detention and late-to-lesson detention.
- ✓ 30-minute afterschool detention – late-to-school detention and Faculty detention.
- ✓ One-hour Leadership Team detention.

It is important to note that although students can receive a long detention as a sanction for a serious incident, the system is tiered. Indeed, failure to attend a 10-minute detention will result in a 30-minute detention, and failure to attend a 30-minute detention will escalate to a one-hour detention.

If your child has failed to attend a 30-minute detention, you will be informed by phone. Please ensure you have downloaded the MyEd application onto your mobile phone, to facilitate communication from the academy. The application can be downloaded using the link below:
