Visit to: (Go)Jump In Enfield, Lumina Park, Lumina Way, Enfield EN1 1FS

Date of Trip: Wednesday 17 April 2024

Our next Focus Day, which is part of our PSHCE curriculum, takes place on Wednesday 17 April. As part of the Year 9 Focus Day, we have organised a trip to the "(Go) Jump In" trampoline park in Enfield. The purpose of this visit is to promote student wellbeing, teamwork and build positive relationships between the students. The day will begin with activities at the academy. **Students are expected to attend Collective Time at the usual time of 8.40am.**

Departure Time and Entrance: 10.30am from Linscott Road

Return Time and Entrance: 3.00pm
Students will be dismissed from Laura Place

Visit Location: (Go)Jump In Enfield, Lumina Park, Lumina Way, Enfield EN1 1FS

180 students will be attending this visit supervised by approximately 14 members of staff. The Visit Leader is Ms. Lucy Bennett, Head of Year 9.

Parents are asked to contribute £9 to cover student entry into the venue and the compulsory purchase of 'grip socks'. Please make the requested payment by **Wednesday 27 March** via ParentPay. Please email finance@clapton.hackney.sch.uk if you have any concerns about the £9 cost of the visit. Parents wishing to make additional contributions toward funding for students whose families are facing financial difficulty can also do so via ParentPay. Any contribution is appreciated. Please be aware that if we do not receive enough contributions, the visit will have to be cancelled. In addition, if there are concerns about your child's behaviour, the decision for them to come on this trip may be reviewed.

We will be walking and using London Overground to travel to and from the venue. Students will be required to top up their Zip cards with a minimum of £3 to enable them to travel on the Overground. It is expected that all listen to and follow instructions from all adults on the visit, including those at the venue. Students will not be allowed to use their mobile phones during the visit and all normal behaviour rules apply.

Students are expected to bring along a healthy packed lunch. Those entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with a sandwich, juice and snack by the school. Students are encouraged to bring a water bottle which they can refill at the venue. Students will not be allowed to visit shops on the way to or from the venue. The students will be expected to wear exercise clothing suitable for trampolining, such as leggings, tracksuits, and trainers.

You have been emailed a link to give consent (via Evolve). The email subject is 'Year 9 Focus Day Visit – (Go)Jump In'. Please click the link to give your consent (via Evolve) and make the requested payment of £9 via ParentPay by Wednesday 27 March. **If the Evolve consent form is not completed by the date shown above, then it is unlikely that your child will be allowed to go on this visit.** Thank you for your support.
