Project Update

Works carried out in the last period of June include:

- Completion of roof, including out falls
- Progression of brickwork to all elevations
- Installation of internal partitions to all levels
- Commencement of mechanical and electrical containment works
- Erection of scaffolding to all elevations

Forthcoming works for July:

- Complete remaining Brickwork
- Install windows and glass to all elevation
- Progress mechanical and electrical, and internal partitioning of all areas
- Commence repairs to the existing Portico building
- Decorate the Existing 2005 building


